1. June 4th **Hidden Figures** 2016 (PG) Drama
Rated PG-13 for some strong language, injury images, and a shot of a man's rear end.
An astronaut becomes stranded on Mars after his team assume him dead, and must rely on his ingenuity to find a way to signal to Earth that he is alive.
2. June 11th
Mid-High **Moana** 2016 (PG) Fantasy
Rated PG for peril, some scary images and brief thematic elements
In Ancient Polynesia, when a terrible curse incurred by the Demigod Maui reaches an impetuous Chieftain's daughter's island, she answers the Ocean's call to seek out the Demigod to set things right.

Sr. High: **Avatar** 2009 (PG-13) Fantasy
Rated PG-13 for intense epic battle sequences and warfare, sensuality, language and some smoking.
In the future, Jake, a paraplegic war veteran, is brought to another planet, Pandora, which is inhabited by the Na'vi, a humanoid race with their own language and culture. Those from Earth find themselves at odds with each other and the local culture.

3. June 25th **Dr. Strange** 2016 (PG-13) Adventure
Rated PG-13 for sci-fi violence and action throughout, and an intense crash sequence
While on a journey of physical and spiritual healing, a brilliant neurosurgeon is drawn into the world of the mystic arts and ultimately becomes one of the most powerful heroes in the Marvel Cinema Universe.
4. July 2th **Cast Away** (PG-13) Drama
Rated PG-13 for intense action sequences and some disturbing images
A FedEx executive must transform himself physically and emotionally to survive a crash landing on a deserted island with no one to talk to but himself and a volleyball.
5. July 9th
Mid-High **BedTime Stories** 2008 (PG) Comedy
Rated PG for some mild rude humor and mild language
Skeeter Bronson, who is just looking for a break, must look after his sister's kids as he works as a maintenance worker at a fine hotel. At night they create bedtime stories together, which start to come true in real life and change everything.

Sr. High: 7/9 **Swing Vote** 2008 (PG-13) Comedy
Rated PG-13 for language
Filmed in New Mexico, a blue collar father who has never placed an interest in politics is forced the center of America's attention when his misplaced ballot holds the key vote in the battle ground state of a national election.

6. July 16th

Mid-High: **Finding Neverland** 2002 (PG) Drama

Rated PG for mild thematic elements and brief language

Looking for a new play to write and produce, J.M. Barrie, discovers a family and a friendship who inspire him to create his greatest known work, Peter Pan.

Sr. High **The King's Speech** 2010 (R) Drama

Rated R for some language

Based on the true story of how King George VI ascended the throne of England as he struggled to overcome his shyness, self worth, and speech impediment.

7. July 23rd **Christmas with the Kranks** 2004 (PG) Comedy

Rated PG-13 for mild language and some sexuality (no nudity), mild drug content, and thematic elements

With their daughter away, the Kranks decide to skip Christmas altogether, but she later decides to come home, causing an uproar when they have to celebrate the holiday at the last minute. *(Part of our Christmas in July Celebration this day)*

8. July 30th

Mid-High **August Rush** 2007 (PG) Drama

Rated PG for some thematic elements, mild violence and language

A drama with fairy tale elements, where an orphaned musical prodigy uses his gift as a clue to finding his birth parents.

Sr. High: **Silence** 2016 (R) Drama

Rated R for violence related to martyrdom

In the 17th century, two Portuguese Jesuit priests travel to Japan to spread Christianity and attempt to locate their mentor, who is rumored to have committed apostasy.

9. August 8th **Lion** 2016 (PG-13) Drama

Rated PG-13 for thematic material and some sensuality

A five-year-old Indian boy gets lost on the streets of Calcutta, thousands of kilometers from home. He survives many challenges before being adopted by a couple in Australia. 25 years later, he sets out to find his lost family.
